The Society invites nominations by the Fellows of the Society for the following awards instituted by the Society. Each award shall consist of a **Plaque of Merit** and a **Certificate** with citation and a onetime fellowship of Rs. 10,000/- for the **N.R. Bhat Memorial Award for Best Research Paper published from the Ph.D. Thesis**. Candidates from any Public or Private Scientific Institution can be nominated for award. The nominations are to be proposed by a Fellow of the Society. The proforma for all the awards are enclosed. 1) Harbhajan Singh Memorial Award (Triennial)

Eligibility : Any citizen of India below the age of 45 years and who has done outstanding work in the exploration, collection and identification of useful germplasm of economic importance during the triennium **2011, 2012 and 2013**

2) Srinivasa Ramanujam Memorial Award (Biennial):

Eligibility : Any citizen of India below the age of 35 years and who is an active member of the Indian Society of Genetics and Plant Breeding and has done outstanding research work in the field of genetics and plant breeding during the biennium **2011 and 2012**. The contribution submitted for consideration should not have received any other award.

3) Joginder Singh Memorial Award (Biennial):

Eligibility: Any citizen of India who has done original and meritorious research work in Maize Genetics and Breeding during the biennium **2011 and 2012**. The contribution submitted for consideration should not have received any other award.

4) V.S. Mathur Memorial Award (Triennial):

Eligibility : Any citizen of India who is an active member of the Indian Society of Genetics and Plant Breeding and has done original and meritorious research work in wheat genetics and breeding during the triennium **2011, 2012 and 2013**. The contribution submitted for consideration should not have received any other award.

5) Best Research Paper Award (Biennial):

Eligibility : Any citizen of India who is an active member of the Indian Society of Genetics and Plant Breeding during the biennium **2011 and 2012** and has published original and meritorious research work in the Indian Journal of Genetics and Plant Breeding. The contribution submitted for consideration should not have been presented or published in any other Journal.

6) N.R. Bhat Memorial Award for Best Research Paper published from the Ph.D. Thesis (Biennial):

Eligibility and procedure for election/selection Fellow of Indian Society of Genetics & Plant Breeding (ISGPB):

- I. A Fellow will be nominated by an existing fellow of the Society from among those who have been Life members of ISGPB for a minimum of 5 years.
- II. A Fellow of ISGPB may make no more than three nominations in a year for the fellowship in the prescribed proforma with supportive evidence of the suitability of the nominee for fellowship. Fellows will be inducted on the basis of their contributions to the field of Genetics & Plant Breeding by the Committee constituted by Executive Committee for this purpose.
- III. A maximum of 20 Fellows will be inducted in a year. The actual number of fellows to be inducted each year, however, will be decided by Executive Committee every year based on the recommendations of the committee constituted for selection of fellows
- IV. A scientist who is not a life member of the ISGPB or has not completed 5 years as a life member can also be nominated as an Honorary Member if he/she has such exceptional and outstanding contribution in the fields of Genetics and Plant Breeding. In this case also the nomination accepted by the EC will be based on the recommendation of the designated committee.
- V. The last date for receipt of complete Nomination papers in ISGPB office will be 31st May 2014.
